We go down, down, down.

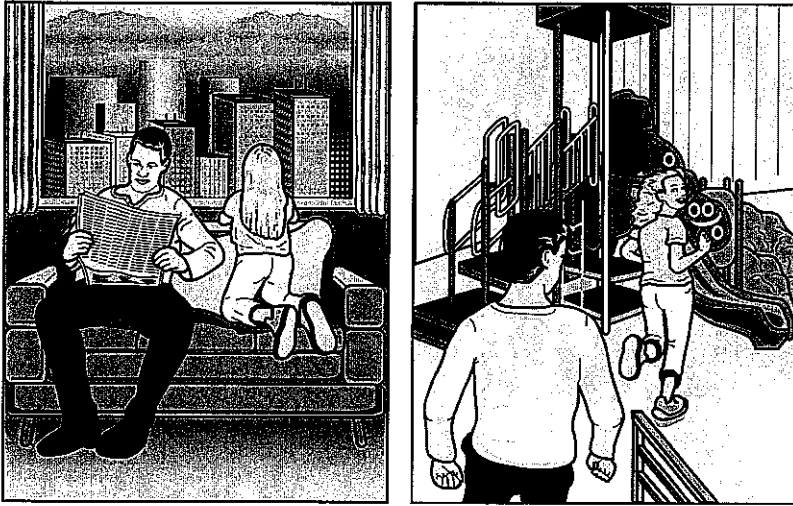
